

Responses for Clarification of 470s for Panhandle Public Library Cooperative System

(covers Calhoun, Holmes, Jackson, Washington, and PPLCS)

1. **What is preference for telephone lines?** Either POTS (plain old telephone service) or VoIP (voice over Internet) is acceptable.
2. **Why is there such a broad range of bandwidth on the 470 forms(from 1.5 Mbps-50 Mbps)?**
This is because there are smaller branch library locations that would be limited to a lower bandwidth speed due to their location. The higher speed location is primarily for the larger branch locations that require more bandwidth due to the number of patrons and library staff working out of the facility.
3. **What is the breakdown of phone lines needed for the Jackson County Public Library System?**
The 470 form requests 6 lines for the Jackson County Public Library System. Four lines are for the Jackson County Public Library in Marianna. Two lines are for the Graceville Public Library in Graceville.
4. **Is there a preference for a 3 or 5 year contract for services?** There is no preference.
5. **What is the breakdown of access points for Washington County Public Library System?** The 470 form requests 3 access points. Two are for the Washington County Public Library located in Chipley. One is needed for the Sam Mitchell Public Library in Vernon.
